Examples include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Volleyball - appropriate footwear (cross-trainers, BB shoes, or VB shoes) and knee pads (optional), Girls-black shorts/lycra Soccer - cleats potentially 2 pairs - one for grass and one for artificial turf (depending on what field/facility the tournaments are held, black shorts & socks, shin guards, possibly indoor soccer shoes too.
